Dance Staff

She has studied ballet, jazz and hip-hop at many dance studios in the Chester County area for 20 years. Ruby was a member of the Brandywine Ballet Theatre for 3 years. She was also a member of the WCU Dance Team for 4 years. Ruby has taught dance classes for children ages 3-10 for 5 years.

What To Bring

All children are asked to bring a towel, bathing suit, sunscreen, and snack. Tights & skirts are optional but please only skirts attached to the leotard. You may also bring leather ballet shoes, not the satin slippers.

Safety First

- Each staff member is CPR trained and certified and able to handle medical issues, including arranging for a higher level of professional help when needed

Special Needs

Children with special needs are encouraged and welcomed to participate in our summer program. If your child has a full time aide or one-on-one companion, arrangements can be made to accommodate these circumstances.

Drop Off & Pick Up

Drop off and pick up is held at Club La Maison. All pickup is held at Club la Maison at 12:00 PM unless attending lunch Bunch. Lunch Bunch pick up is at Club House behind Club La Maison at 1:00 PM

Cancellation Policy

There is no refund for missed days due to illness or vacation. A one-week notice is required to cancel any session in order to receive a full refund. Staffing is planned ahead of time and is based on the number of children enrolled.

Lunch Bunch

Lunch Bunch is held for children who attend a morning half day camp. Lunch bunch is an extended hour from 12:00-1:00pm at the CLM club house. Each camper will need to bring a lunch and drink. During this additional hour, campers will eat lunch, play in the game room and continue with organized activities during this time. Pickup for children is held at the outdoor clubhouse. Lunch Bunch can be paid daily.
