So what will we be doing? Fair question! We will be following all safety protocols and guidelines outlined by the Pennsylvania Department of Health including, but not limited to:

- Staff will be required to wear masks and will have their temperature taken prior to starting their shift.
- Hand washing or sanitizing will be implemented every time we switch activities.
- Additional staff will be utilized to clean and sanitize touch points and shared toys after each activity.
- All campers will be required to report their temperature upon arrival to camp.
- We will limit the mixing of children by staggering playground and other activity times.
